 - Disassemble and reassemble watch movements, ensuring precision and meticulous attention to detail;
 - Clean, oil, and regulate watch components, including adjusting timing and accuracy;
 - Replace and repair damaged or worn watch parts, such as crystals, hands, dials, and crowns;

- Collaborate with colleagues to ensure efficient workflow and timely completion of repairs;
- Maintain accurate records of all repairs, including parts used, labour performed, and customer details;
- Stay updated with the latest watchmaking techniques, tools, and technologies through continuous learning and professional development.
