Job Description

Duties:

- Supervise, co-ordinate, and schedule the activities of workers on job sites and in the shop
- Read and interpret architectural drawings, shop drawings, and installation plans
- Ensure all installations meet quality standards, project specifications, and timelines
- Resolve work problems, provide technical advice, and recommend measures to improve productivity and product quality
- Train or arrange for training of workers
- Recommend personnel actions, such as hirings and dismissals

- Assemble, install, and finish Italian cabinets and custom millwork with accuracy and precision
- Perform detailed site measurements and make on-site adjustments and modifications as required
- Build custom cabinets and millwork in the shop according to drawings and specifications
- Shape surfaces or edges of wood workpieces, using hand tools, such as planes, chisels, wood files, CNC, table saws, and edge banding saws
- Safely operate all hand tools, power tools, and shop machinery
- Ensure standards and regulations for safe working conditions are observed
- Maintain a clean, organized, and safe work environment on job sites and in the shop
- Sand wooden surfaces and apply veneer, stain or polish to finished products
- Prepare specifications of custom-made cabinets that maximize storage
- Study plans, specifications or drawings of articles to be made

Qualifications:

- Secondary school completion is required;
- College diploma or certification in a recognized cabinetmaker course is preferred
- 3-5 years of previous work experience in cabinet and millwork installation is required
- Previous supervisory experience is required
