Job Description

Duties:

- Review work orders and discuss work to be performed with supervisor
- Inspect and test engine and other mechanical components using test devices to diagnose and isolate faults
- Adjust, repair or replace mechanical or electrical system parts and components using hand tools and equipment
- Test and adjust repaired systems for proper performance
- Ensure work is performed in accordance with dealership and factory standards
- Perform scheduled maintenance service on equipment
- Advise customers on work performed and general condition of equipment
- Determine estimates of repair cost

- Communicate with parts department to obtain needed parts
- Complete and maintain documentation of work performed
- Road-test motorcycles to quality-check work performed
- Keep the shop area neat, clean, and free of safety hazards
- Comply with Federal, Provincial and Municipal regulations, such as those governing the disposal of hazardous wastes
- Follow company safety policies and practices, and immediately, report any and all accidents to a Manager/Supervisor;
- This position will be expected to perform other duties as assigned by management.
