- Plan and maintain a safe and healthy learning environment
- Assess children's abilities, interests, and needs and discuss progress with parents and colleagues
- Observe children for signs of learning or behavioural issues and prepare reports when necessary
- Guide children in developing proper eating, dressing, and toileting habits
- Establish and maintain collaborative relationships with coworkers and community service providers
- Supervise and coordinate activities of ECE assistants when necessary
