- Assist with the setup, operation, cleaning, lubrication, and routine maintenance of the asphalt paver and screed equipment.
- Identify and correct irregularities in the asphalt mat, including uneven thickness, segregation, roughness, and improper slope.

- Follow grade stakes, string lines, laser guidance, survey information, and other paving indicators to maintain required elevations and grades.
- Communicate with crew members using hand signals and other communication methods to coordinate safe and efficient paving operations.
- Perform daily inspections of the paver and screed components and report mechanical or operational issues to the supervisor.
- Follow all workplace health and safety regulations and company policies.
- Assist with other asphalt paving and construction duties as required by the project supervisor or foreman.
