music, going for walks, social outings, being read to, and watching movies. The ideal candidate will be attentive, patient, and comfortable providing full personal care while also creating a positive and engaging environment.

Main Duties:

Provide full personal care including bathing, dressing, toileting, and hygiene support

Perform safe transfers using mechanical lifts and mobility equipment

Administer medications, enteral feeding (G-tube), and hydration as per care plan

Support communication using assistive devices (e.g., eye gaze system, yes/no communication tools)

Assist with range-of-motion exercises, positioning, and light massage to support mobility and reduce muscle stiffness

Plan, organize, and participate in recreational and social activities

Monitor and document health status; report any changes or concerns to family/employer

Maintain a clean and safe environment for the client

Skills and Experience Requirements:

Secondary (high) school graduation certificate required
