- Facilitate safety inspections;
- Repair equipment and replace parts where appropriate;
- Assess equipment to see if it needs to be sent out for repair;
- Recognize and report faults or malfunctions on all company equipment, not limited to loaders, skid steer, forklifts and hydraulic systems;
- Ensure all service and maintenance practices meet the regulatory requirements for the MTO, MOL, and the MOE;
- Coordinate and control the daily scheduling of service and repair of all road and plant equipment;
