- Compute dimensions and tolerances of machine parts, including corrections needed to achieve accurate bends and dimensions in accordance with drawing specifications
- Measure and lay out work pieces in preparation for assembly
- Read and interpret engineering drawings, blueprints, charts and tables to plan machining operations
- Repair machine tools and parts, including performing preventative maintenance, general housekeeping, and determining when repairs or new equipment are needed
- Set up and adjust production machineries/tools to complete fabrication in accordance with established time standards
- Fit and assemble components and machine parts to close tolerance
- Maintain, repair and calibrate precision measuring instruments (e.g., verniers)
- Document and report deviations from specifications and tolerances, and ensure the identification process for components is followed
- Maintain inspection records and complete inspection reports, including “first-off” inspections of components against drawings and completion of manufacturing process documentation
- Verify dimensions of parts machined using precise measuring instruments (e.g., micrometres, calipers)
- Set up and operate conventional and computer controlled machine tools, including loading, running, and modifying CNC programs, and programming CNC operations from technical drawings and blueprints
- Verify dimensions of products for accuracy and conformance to specifications using precision measuring instruments
