- Design and develop software architecture, backend services, databases, APIs, and system components supporting RFID-based product identification, inventory management, logistics tracking, cold-chain visibility, and product traceability.
- Design, develop, customize, and maintain APIs, interfaces, and data exchange solutions to integrate the BlueTrace™ platform with customers' ERP systems, warehouse management systems (WMS), logistics platforms, and other third-party applications.
- Develop and maintain data models, business logic, and processing workflows for RFID events, crate movements, inventory transactions, product records, temperature-related logistics data, and other operational information.
- Configure, implement, and integrate new software modules, RFID devices, sensors, cloud services, and related technologies to support customer implementations and evolving business requirements.
