Duties:

Read and interpret engineering drawings, blueprints, work orders, and specifications, including geometric dimensions and tolerances (GD&T)

Plan and execute machining operations by selecting appropriate tools, materials, reference points, and machining parameters

Set up, program, and operate CNC and manual machines such as lathes, milling machines, drills, and saws to produce precision parts

Machine parts to required specifications, verifying accuracy and tolerances using gauges and measuring instruments

Inspect finished parts, troubleshoot issues, and isolate or correct non-conforming pieces

Load and unload materials safely; monitor stock levels and request supplies when needed

Perform routine maintenance, lubrication, adjustments, and minor repairs on machines, tools, and equipment

Shape, sharpen, and adjust cutting tools to meet project requirements

Suggest and implement improvements to tooling, fixturing, and machining processes

Maintain accurate production records, time and labour reports, and follow quality-control procedures
